BERRY CREEK EVACUATION ZONE A HAS BEEN REDUCED TO AN EVACUATION WARNING

WHEN: Monday November 19th, 2018 at 2:00 P.M.

WHERE: The Berry Creek evacuation zone A has been reduced to a warning except for the following areas: Encina Grande Road at Deer Meadow Rd, Bloomer Hill Road at Black Bear Road remain under and evacuation order. Hwy 162 at Four Mile Ridge Road will remain closed to all northbound traffic. Berry Creek Zones B and C remain under and evacuation order.

NOTES: Residents need to be aware that the areas being lifted have very limited services. Prior to returning home, residents are encouraged to take steps to ensure they have food, water, and fuel for their vehicles.

Fire personnel are still active in the area. Please reduce speeds and drive with caution. The cancellation of additional evacuation orders is being evaluated based on a variety of factors, including potential fire behavior and life safety hazards.

SAFETY MESSAGE – The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. Please continue to adhere to road closures and any evacuation warnings. A reminder to drive slowly and yield to emergency personnel in the area. There will be smoke in the respective areas as firefighters continue firefighting operations. If at any time you feel unsafe, please call 911.
